

**OVERALL CARE PATHWAY
THERAPY SERVICES – VICTIMS OF SEXUAL ABUSE; SEXUALLY HARMFUL BEHAVIOURS**

Referral to LPFT weekly screening meeting for victims of sexual abuse or those displaying sexually harmful behaviour or directly to PMHW (see PMHW pathway)

Pathway for victims of sexual abuse
 Pathway for those with sexually harmful behaviour
 Service provided for both client groups
 Youth Offending Service delivery

* Where it is felt that a young person is in need of both CAMHS and on-going Social Care support referrals can be made for an assessment of a young person's social care needs at any time.

**Service users age 18 should continue to receive treatment until their 19th birthday, as appropriate, if treatment has begun

For children/young people presenting with significant sexually concerning behaviours a Core Assessment needs to have been completed as a minimum prior to referral to Tier 3 Harmful Behaviour Service.

Ensure referrer escalates to Customer Service Centre to allow Social Care safeguarding assessment or where this is not possible. LPFT to contact Customer Service Centre 01522 782111

Has referring agency followed Safeguarding procedure to screen if young person is living in safe environment?

Ensure intervention is addressing sexually harmful behaviours as appropriate

Young person displaying sexually harmful behaviour

Victim of sexual abuse

Ensure intervention is addressing sexual abuse as appropriate

YOS deliver AIMS Assessment and Intervention work with young person

Do the presenting concerns detailed indicate a need for a more detailed assessment? i.e. an AIMS assessment

Has an AIMS Assessment been completed?

Specialist Therapist or psychologist from Harmful Behaviour Service to identify with referrer and other involved agencies two workers to complete AIMS Assessment

Specialist Therapist or psychologist from Harmful Behaviour Service to attend AIMS Strategy meeting or meet with referrer, carers and other involved professionals and agree intervention

YOS continue AIMS and upon end of YOS involvement ensure CAMHS YOS Nurse and/or Specialist Therapist picks up case until appropriate discharge

Does young person also require support from CAMHS?

Forensic Psychology Assessment by CAMHS (referrals may come from other CAMHS clinicians in rare circumstances) Mainly MAPPA 2/3 Level

Tier 3
Moderate to severe concern – Specialist Therapist to lead on delivery of intervention

Tier 2
Mild to moderate concern - PMHW to deliver Tier 2 intervention

Tier 3
Moderate to severe concern – Nurse Specialist to deliver Tier 3 intervention

CAMHS YOS Nurse to deliver intervention mainly below MAPPA 2/3 level

Following Discharge:
A) No Further Action
B) Referred to other agency for Support
C) Transition to AMHS
